
Proposed Timescales

- Jan/Feb should receive notification of the results (we might get all or part of what we have asked for)
- March July 2024 consultation with WSCC Highways and obtaining of necessary permissions
- Summer/Autumn 2024 start on site






The Fleet crossing





Lower Street pavement and crossing/ Church Lane








The Swan Inn - improved public realm
